



Registering your ESP License

Your license of ESP will need to be registered if any of the following is true:

- You are installing a new copy of ESP for the first time
- You are extending the temporary expiry date of ESP for an evaluation copy
- You are adding more departments to a computer that already has ESP
- You are reinstalling after a computer crash or replacement

Start ESP and open the data file you wish to license. From the [HOME](#) form, choose [FILE | OPTIONS](#) from the menu, and select the [DEPARTMENTS](#) tab as shown above. Enter information for each column. Note that the [ID](#) must uniquely identify your location, and is normally your location number. The [NAME](#) is typically a more descriptive name that is printed on all your reports.

Once you have defined your store and department information, select the [LICENSING](#) tab.

Fill out the remaining information fields as described below:

Machine ID: Do not change this. If you accidentally overwrite this field, click the [RESET](#) button to reset it back to the correct value.

License name: Enter your company or corporate name. If you are a franchised location it should be the name of the company that your franchisee uses.

Site name: This must be the same as the Department ID that you entered on the Departments tab. Normally this is automatically filled in and you should not change it.

Site count: Set this to 1 unless you are scheduling multi-department or satellite locations that share employees with your primary location.

Home path: This should be filled in for you automatically with the path to your ESP data file. You should not change this unless you are familiar with ESP data files and their location.

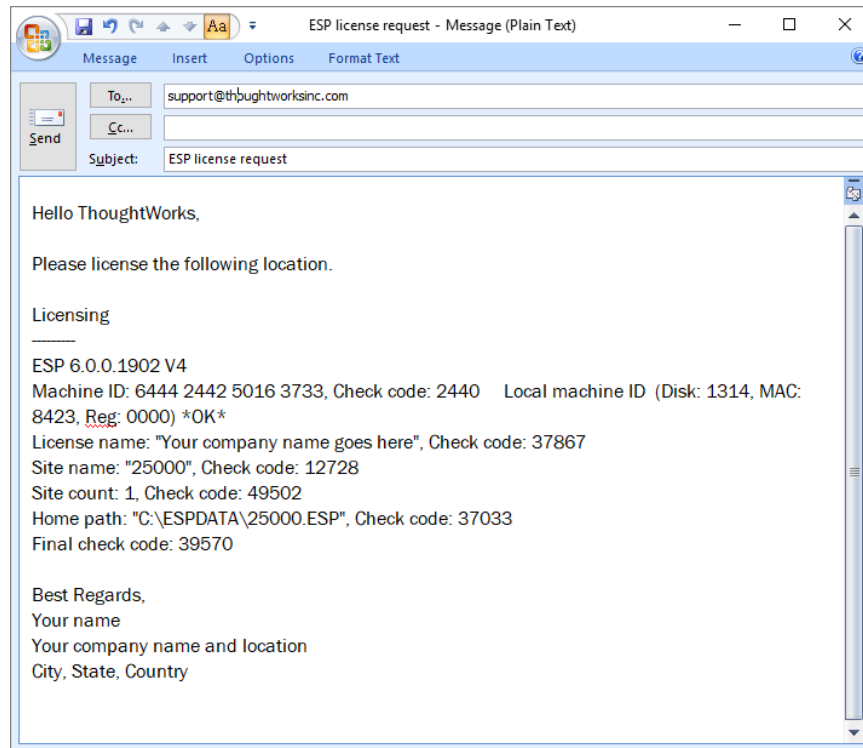

Create a new mail message using your e-mail software, with support@thoughtworksinc.com as the addressee. In the body of the message, paste your information by pressing CTRL-V, or by clicking EDIT | PASTE from the menu. Your e-mail should look something like this:
